RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the Parish School Board of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana (the "School Board") to amend, supplement and reappoint the members to the Board of Directors of the Educational Facilities Improvement District of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, and further providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:2740.37 (the "EFID Act") creates the Educational Facilities Improvement District of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana (the "District") for the purpose of assisting school boards experiencing financial difficulties regarding capital facilities or other needs: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to La. R.S. 33:2740.37(C), each district shall be administered and governed by a board of directors comprised of not less than five (5) members appointed by the School Board; and

WHEREAS, in the Regular meeting of the Washington Parish School Board of March 7, 2024 the School Board appointed members to the Education Facilities Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to supplement the members of the Board of Directors of the Educational Facilities Improvement District by adding the names of <u>Tarmecia Partman</u> and <u>Darlene Fugate</u> as members.

THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED by this School Board as the governing authority of the District, that the resolution of the School Board adopted in its meeting of March 7, 2024 is hereby amended, supplemented, and restated as follows:

SECTION 1. This School Board hereby approves the appointment of the following board members to serve on the Board of Directors of the Educational Facilities Improvement District of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana:

RESOLUTION

A Resolution expressing opposition to state legislation establishing Education Savings Accounts (ESAs), including House Bill 745 which creates the LA GATOR Scholarship Program, that provide public dollars for private school tuition and educational expenses and to urge the Washington Parish legislative delegation to vote NO on any bill proposing an Education Savings Account, and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

WHEREAS, there is a renewed and concerted effort at the legislature to pass bills that will give public funds directly to parents to be used for private school tuition and other educational expenses with little to no oversight; and

WHEREAS, for the past 2() years, the state has failed to adequately fund K-12 public education; and

WHEREAS, during that same period the state has continuously placed new accountability demands on both our students and our schools; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish School Board provides free public K-12 education to any student who resides in our school district within the guidelines set by both the state and federal government; and

WHEREAS, diverting public dollars to private schools and other programs through Education Savings Accounts (ESAs) without fully funding public schools disadvantages our students and schools; and

WHEREAS, providing public dollars to ESAs without requiring the same state accountability testing imposed on public school students is irresponsible public policy.

THEREFORE, the Washington Parish School Board does hereby express its OPPOSITION to legislation creating and/or

FURTHER, the Washington Parish School Board directs the superintendent of the Washington Parish School System to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to each member of the legislative delegation of Washington Parish.
